**Iconic Miami Tower Lights up in gold For
the DOWNTOWN MIAMI-BOUND New Orleans Saints**

MIAMI, FL — February 1, 2010 – Downtown Miami is rolling out the welcome mat for the New Orleans Saints. On the news that the NFC Champions will be lodging at Downtown Miami's Intercontinental Hotel during Super Bowl week, the iconic I.M. Pei-designed *Miami Tower* office building will be illuminated in a sea of gold lights. The *Miami Tower* will be lit in Saints colors February 1, 2 and 3 to mark the team's Downtown Miami arrival, according to the Miami Downtown Development Authority.

Miami Tower 100 SE 2nd Street is a 47-story, 600,000 square-foot I.M. Pei-designed office tower in Downtown Miami. The class-A tower has earned 'icon' status for its changing palette of exterior lighting schemes timed to coincide with holidays, sporting events and other significant occasions.
