## Miami Circle Park

>> Last month's groundbreaking ceremony marked the advent of the long awaited Miami Circle Park at the mouth of the Miami River.

Phase I of the park is expected to open to the public early next year.

The 2,000-year-old ruins of a Tequesta Indian village will remain buried to ensure their preservation, but visitors will have unrestricted access to the site, which will be enhanced with native plantings, interpretative panels and benches.

Starting this fall, the Historic Museum of Southern Florida will provide tours beginning at the museum, where ancient treasures unearthed at the site are on display, and continuing on to the Miami Circle via Metromover.
