

Flagler Street Beautification Project

February 9, 2022 Construction Alert #36:

- The NE and NW corners on the northside of Flagler Street and 2nd Avenue are closed off to pedestrians
- This closure started on Tuesday, February 7, 2023, and should end on Friday, February 10, 2023.
- The area should reopen on Friday evening. This is due to sidewalk reconstruction and concrete delivery.
- The following businesses from 2nd Ave to 1st Ave will remain open for businesses:

Alfred Dupont Building, Primos Red Tacos, Lost Boys, Over 7 Under, UPS Store, D&R Perfumes, The Bead District, Moises Jewelry, CJ Urban Wear and Watch Time.

• During this temporary closure, to access these stores, please walk from 1st Avenue eastbound on Flagler Street. You will be able to walk on the south side of Flagler Street.



- The SE and SW corners on the southside of Flagler Street and 2nd Avenue will now be closed off to pedestrians on **Monday**, **February 13**, **2023**.
- The area should reopen on that same day, Monday evening. This is due to sidewalk reconstruction.
- The following businesses from 2nd Avenue to 1st Avenue will remain open for businesses:

 Miara Porfumes, Olympia Theater, Fornand Ontical, Pok MIA, Mr. Tony's Shop, M.

Miara Perfumes, Olympia Theater, Fernand Optical, Rok MIA, Mr. Tony's Shop, Metro Digital Computer, and Wells Fargo Bank.
