

CENSUS 2020 EVERYBODY COUNTS!



Every 10 years, the Census Bureau counts every person in the U.S.

WHO

All people (including kids) living or staying at an address must be counted, not just the person or family who owns or rents the property.



WHEN

- March 2020 you can begin responding to the 2020 Census by mail, phone or online at 2020census.gov
- 22220
- · April 1, 2020 Census Day
- June 2020 July 2020—Census Bureau employees will go door to door to count people who have not responded to the 2020 Census. Census Bureau employees must provide proof that they are official government personnel.

WHY

The federal government will decide how much funding to give to states, counties, and cities based on the number of people they count. That means more money for



- · building and updating schools
- building new hospitals
- repairing broken roads and building new roads
- maintaining public utilities like water, sewer, and power
- creating jobs
- supporting programs for your community
