


Project Map - Divided into Five (5) Sections













Typical Traffic Detour During Construction









Street Phasing of Construction – Roadway






- Work to begin within the 50' roadway area inclusive of the pavement and adjacent sidewalks → Construction Zone
- A walkway will remain on each side of the street → pedestrian access to the businesses and connectivity along the corridor



Street Phasing of Construction - Sidewalk





- When street pavement and adjacent sidewalk and landscape is complete, work will switch to the 10' sidewalk areas.
- The roadway will remain closed to vehicular traffic but will be open for pedestrian access.
- Construction Zone → Closed but access to businesses will be provided
