- Arrival of drainage structures and pipes.
- Roadway excavations and hauling off debris in Section B in preparation for new roadway design.
- Installation of signs promoting business open for service.

- Abandonment of existing drainage in Section A and replacement of new drainage.
- Back filling of structures and drainage.
- Excavations and soft digs for proposed trench drain for Sections A & B.








